

**Program Name:** LSU Health Shreveport

**Size of intern class:** 4

**Application Process:** Applications are accepted through ERAS and reviewed in a holistic way to identify residents who are truly interested in Med-Peds and would be a good fit for our program.

**Number and types of letters of recommendations:** 3-4 letters from physicians with whom the applicant has worked with clinically are requested. Departmental or “chair” letters are accepted but not required. In light of restrictions on applicants’ experience due to covid, letter writers can be from any field. If possible, we would like to see at least one letter from an internist, pediatrician, or a Med-Peds physician.

**Application review/invite timeline:** We generally start reviewing applications as soon as available and will start sending out invitations that same week. The process of reviewing these takes time in order to give all applications their due justice, and some invitations will take longer depending on the volume that we have to review.

**Approach to Step 1:** There is not a minimum score for Step 1.

**Approach to Step 2:** There is not a minimum score for Step 2.

**Post-Interview Communication Policy:** We do not encourage post-interview communication and in non-covid times, we would allow second looks if an applicant requests one.
