Program Name: Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai Combined Internal Medicine-Pediatrics

Program Mission: Our mission is to reduce inequities in marginalized and oppressed populations by training leaders in MedPeds primary care.

Size of intern class: 4

Application Process: ERAS with 100% virtual interviews

Number and types of letters of recommendations: We recommend letters from letter writers who know you well and can speak to your strengths as an applicant. This year especially we recognize that letters from both medicine and pediatric faculty may not be attainable for all residents. Departmental letters of recommendation are not required. ERAS typically allows up to 4 letters.

Application review/invite timeline: We plan to begin inviting applicants at the end of October, and will start interviews mid-November. We do not use a "waitlist." All applicants who are offered an interview will have an opportunity to interview should they choose to do so.

Approach to Step 1: We take an anti-racist approach to recruitment, as described [here](#). In alignment with our community-developed mission we prioritize inviting applicants who demonstrate dedication to primary care and dedication to social and racial justice. While Step 1 scores are reviewed by the Program Director in the context of your entire application, there is no cut off for an interview and our selections committee is blinded to all step scores.

Approach to Step 2: Refer to our answer for Step 1. Receiving an interview is not contingent on having taken Step 2.

Post-Interview Communication Policy: Program leadership, faculty and residents are available before, during and after the interview day to answer any and all question you have about our program and our community. Our answers will be factual and will not imply any rank order. Similarly, communication with us will not affect the rank.
