**Program Name:** University of Minnesota

**Size of intern class:** 10

**Application Process:** We do a holistic review of each application and our assessment of experiences, attributes and academic metrics seeks to promote social and racial justice, and strives to eliminate those metrics that perpetuate structural racism.

**Number and types of letters of recommendations:** We require 3 letters of recommendation, and no specific types are required. Ideal letter writers would be people who have worked with the applicant closely in a clinical setting.

**Application review/invite timeline:** We generally begin interview invitations about 2-3 weeks after the applications have opened, depending on the number of applications received. We release waves of interview offers spaced several days apart, and have an applicant managed waiting list once spots are full.

**Approach to Step 1:** We approach Step 1 as pass/fail.

**Approach to Step 2:** A pass is required for ranking, but not for interviewing.

**Post-Interview Communication Policy:** The program will not send any individualized communication to applicants after the interview day -- all communications will go to all applicants who have interviewed. Applicants are free to contact or communicate with whoever or whenever they wish.
