-Primary care or fellowships in both/either

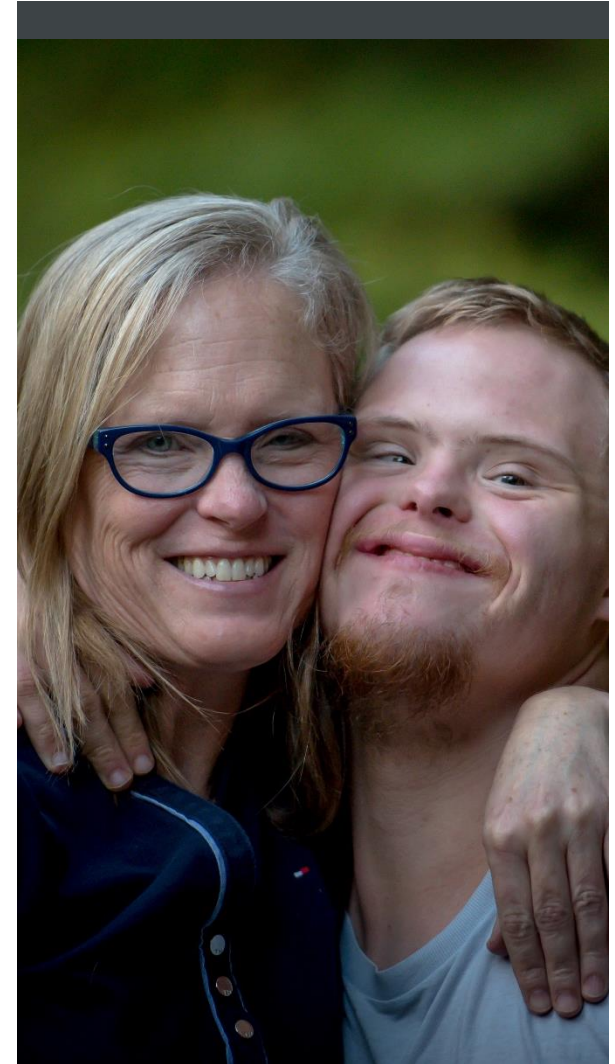

- Know and see as much of health system(s) to bring the proper perspective through the depth and breadth of clinical training.

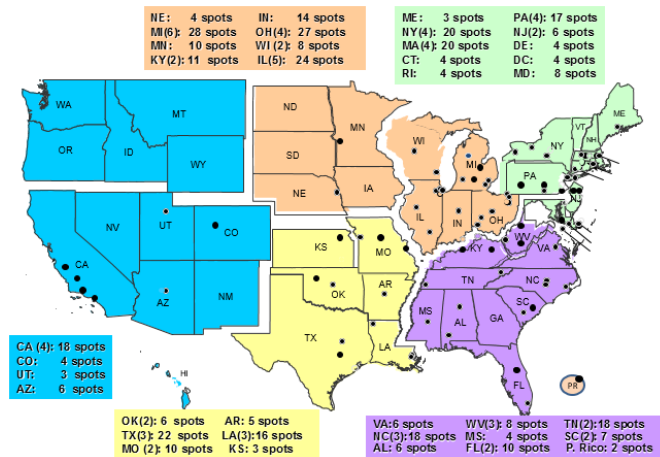


- “Adaptable” to changing circumstances

Med-Peds Match 2016 (79 programs with 386 positions)



Med-Peds Residency programs are located all across the U.S., in any locale you would like to practice! Programs vary in size from 2-14 residents per class. After residency, you can choose to practice or pursue a fellowship in Medicine, Pediatrics, or both!

- 50-60% go into Primary Care
 - 77-93% see both peds & adults
- 18-25% pursue Fellowship
 - ~50% see both peds and adults

How to get involved:

- Get in touch with residents and faculty at your local institution
- Participate in community projects, such as the Annual Service Day
